<p>What if I do not agree with the Conference?</p> <p>If you are not happy or do not agree with the discussion at the Conference, do not be afraid to make your views known or to get your supporter to speak for you.</p> <p>What happens if I need to have a child protection plan?</p> <p>A small group of people will spend time helping you and your family to sort out the difficulties. This group is called the core group.
