



Child Protection On-Line Learning

The structure of the courses include:

- Understanding the various types of abuse or harm to a child
- Identifying signs of abuse and what to look for
- Knowing how to ask questions if you suspect a child is being abused
- Knowing what steps you can take if you suspect abuse or harm
- Understanding what happens after a referral to Social Care is made
- Knowing what to do if a child or adult discloses abuse
- Understanding the importance of keeping records
- What to do if you suspect abuse or deliberate harm to a child

Both courses cover similar material but the Core Introduction deals with this in more depth as appropriate for the increased level of contact that staff will have with children and their families.

The learning package has interactive learning screens, learner challenges, tracking, online assessment and will issue a certificate once the learner attains the required score on the challenges. For a free demonstration learners can visit www.safeguardingchildren.co.uk.

The courses are ideal for everyone who comes into contact with children, young people, their parents or carers through their work in either the statutory or voluntary or independent sector and are endorsed by Staffordshire Safeguarding Children Board and are in line with our Training Strategy.

The Courses

1. The Awareness of Child Abuse & Neglect - Short Foundation course can be taken to **support** an induction process and to **demonstrate** evidence of undertaking the Introduction to Safeguarding Children (1) level of the SSCB Training Strategy and is suitable for staff who may see particular children and/or their parents and carers, but have no on-going relationship with them. Estimated total time required to complete is 60 -90 minutes. The course does not have to be completed in one session.

2. The Awareness of Child Abuse & Neglect - Core Introduction course can be taken to **support** an induction process and to **demonstrate** evidence for staff undertaking the Introduction to Safeguarding Children (2) level of the SSCB Training Strategy and is suitable for those who work regularly with children and young people and with adults who are parents and/or carers, staff who have an on-going level of contact with children and/or their parents. Estimated total time required to complete is 60 -120 minutes. The course does not have to be completed in one session.

Please Note: these courses do not replace the need for statutory agencies to provide 'face-to-face' Level 1 training for staff who have an on-going level of contact with children and/or their parents and carers.
